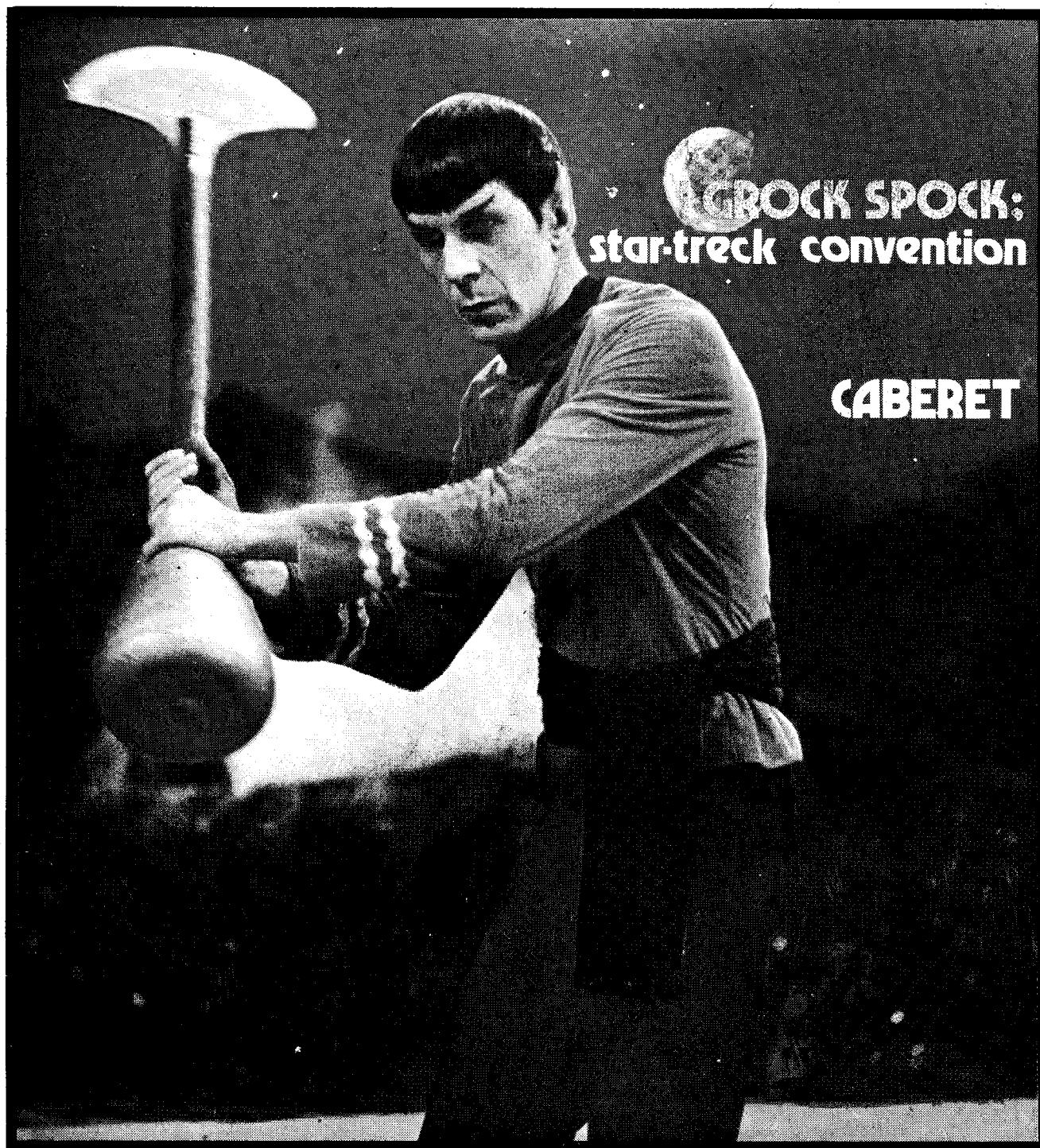


THE NEWS LOSES; A TALE OF 3 SUBPOENAS

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While I am mentioning worthwhile centers of the arts, there is one called **The Kitchen**, 240 Mercer St., in the Mercer Arts Center, which has been presenting some of the most innovative electronic music and mixed media performances, with some of the most brilliant artists around, to audiences that are so small that they amount to private showings. Admission is by contribution, which they usually forget to collect. Last Sunday I attended a live performance of music by Gordon Mumma, Frederick Rzewski, Jeff Lewine, and Garrett List; a few weeks ago, La Monta Young was there. If you recognize these names, I needn't tell you any more, otherwise, you can expect a contemporary music performance of high quality.
