THIS PROJECT WILL BE CARRIED OUT BY THE MEANS OF HIGH QUALITY CONVENTIONAL VIDEO EQUIPMENT IN INTERACTION WITH PER-SONALIZED ELECTRO-OPTICAL DEVICES DEVELOPED AND PROGRAMMED TO CAPTURE AND EXPRESS THE UNIQUENESS OF EACH RECORDED SIGHT (SITE).

IT WILL BE CONDUCTED IN THE SOUTH-WEST REGION OF THE UNITED STATES FOR THE FOLLOWING REASONS:

1. DUE TO CLIMATIC AND GEOGRAPHIC CONDITIONS IN THIS REG-ION, ANY ACTION OF MAN STAYS RECORDED FOR A LONG PERIOD OF TIME.

2. THE LANDSCAPE, BY ITS DIMENSION AND BY ITS GEOMETRIC AND TEXTURAL VARIETY, INSPIRES MAN TO CREATE HARMONIOUS STRUCTURES, DWELLINGS AND OTHER EARTH WORKS.

3. IN NO OTHER REGION OF THIS CONTINENT DOES THE PRESENCE OF THE SUN PLAY SUCH SIGNIFICANT ROLE IN THE ECOLOGY OF LAND, ARRID AND ERODED, WITH AN EXEPTIONAL CLARITY OF THE NIGHT SKIES, FORMING NOTION OF EXTRA TERRESTIAL IMPORTANCE IN THE MINDS OF ITS INHABITANTS.
