The last meeting of the Film Selection Committee took place in 1975.) The foreign language films in the Repertory Collection, with the exception of Dreyer's Gertrud and Cocteau's Le Sang d'un Poète, do not have English subtitles; program notes and a synopsis are available for each foreign language film at the reception desk at the time of showing.
